

How to install nopcommerce mobile module (mobishop)

1. Download and install nopCommerce shopping cart solution
<http://www.nopcommerce.com/Downloads.aspx>
2. After the shopping cart is installed on your web server and is working download mCommerce mobiShop plugin.

3. Suppose your store is installed on your root folder in the website, we'll name it **root**. Files in mobiShop package will be marked in **red**. Files on your web server will be marked in **green**. Copy all **DLL** files from mobiShop package to your **root/bin/** folder (**CatchyTechMobile.dll**, **CatchyTechMobile.Libs.dll**, **CatchyTechMobile.Payment.GoogleMobileCheckout.dll**, **CatchyTechMobile.Payment.PayPalMobile.dll**)
4. Copy **App_Themes/mobiTheme** (and all its contents) folder to your **root/App_Themes/** folder.
5. Copy **m** (and all its contents) folder to your **root/** folder.
6. In your **root/web.config** file after `<system.web>` add the following:
`<xhtmlConformance mode="Strict"/>`
(Look at web.config file in mobiShop package for example).

7. In your **root/UrlRewriting.config** file, just after `<rewrites>` add the following:

```
<add name="ProductDetailsRewriteMobile"
virtualUrl="^~/m/Products/([0-9]*)-([\w-]*)\.aspx(?:\?(.*))?"
rewriteUrlParameter="ExcludeFromClientQueryString"
destinationUrl="~/m/Product.aspx?ProductID=$1&;$3"
ignoreCase="true" />
```

```
<add name="CategoryDetailsRewriteMobile"
virtualUrl="^~/m/Category/([0-9]*)-([\w-]*)\.aspx(?:\?(.*))?"
rewriteUrlParameter="ExcludeFromClientQueryString"
destinationUrl="~/m/Category.aspx?CategoryID=$1&;$3"
ignoreCase="true" />
```

8. Run SQL scripts from **_SqlScripts** in your database. This will add PayPal mobile support to nopCommerce Admin section.
9. Now this one is not a must, but if you want better mobile phone detection (recommended for better image resizing) then do it too. Copy **App_Browsers/Devices** (and all its contents) folder to your **root/App_Browsers/** folder (This is a large file so if you have a slow hosting, perhaps you will have to compress (zip) it before uploading and then uncompress).
10. This step is needed if you like the store to redirect all mobile users automatically to the mobile store.
First backup **root/MastertPages/Root.Master** file from your web server.

Now copy **MasterPages/ copy to root_masetrpages_/Root.Master** from mobiShop package to **root/MasterPages/** folder on your server (overwrite).

11. That's it. Now try to access your store (suppose that the store domain name is yourStore): **http://yourStore/m/**
